



Call for proposals: Clinical phenotyping of ASXL-related disorders at the 2024 ASXL Family Conference

Due date: January 15, 2024

The ARRE Foundation is accepting research grant proposals for clinical phenotyping of the ASXL-related disorders at the 2024 ASXL Family Conference. The award amount is up to \$85,000 to support projects from January 1-December 31, 2024 that center on in-person data collection at the 2024 ASXL Family Conference in Baltimore, Md. from July 18-21, 2024. Projects must be inclusive of data collection and analysis with the intent to publish results.

To apply, please send a brief written proposal including a budget to info@arrefoundation.org by January 15, 2024. A simple format including bullet points is acceptable. The proposal should include:

Identification and description of the goals for the grant period, including a timeline for project milestones and deliverables. Please include a target number of participants and anticipated data types to be collected.

- A description of project collaborators and their roles
- A description of how the data collected will incorporate the ASXL Registry and Biobank at UCLA
- A description of how the project will be responsive to the needs of the ASXL family community
- A description of anticipated challenges, and how the ARRE Foundation can assist in mitigating these challenges
- A projection of the impact of this project on the published body of literature on ASXL-related disorders
- Budget and budget justification

Please note that it is the policy of the ARRE Foundation not to support indirect expenses.

Institutional overhead policy

As a steward of funds raised by families affected by ASXL-related disorders, no ARRE Foundation funds may be used to support indirect costs/overhead expenses. Acceptance of ARRE Foundation funds is contingent upon the recipient and their institution complying with this policy.



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
